On the first day of the conference, an expedition to NIRS to observe a rotating gantry using high-temperature superconducting magnets will be offered. On the last day of the conference, you will have the opportunity to tour the ion-beam Radiation Oncology Center in Kanagawa (i-ROCK), which specializes in a scanning irradiation method using four in-room computed tomography units.

Early May is one of the most wonderful times of the year to visit Japan. From Yokahama, you can embark on an enjoyable day trip to the historic cities of Kamakura and Hakone, which is famous for its hot springs. We also will be hosting a Gala Dinner at the Yokohama Museum of Art; it is very close to the conference venue and you will have the opportunity to enjoy its many works of fine art before dining.






